

NOTICE TO FIREWORKS VENDORS

City of Vaughan Licensing By-law 315-2005 allows and licenses the retail sale of Consumer Fireworks for *seven (7) days immediately preceeding* Victoria Day (May 23) and Canada Day (July 1).

All license applicants must complete an application form and submit all required documentation to confirm business registration with the Ministry of Consumer and Business Services, and the successful completion of the Awareness Training Course offered by the Vaughan Fire & Rescue Service on the safe sale, storage, display, use and handling of consumer fireworks. In addition, both zoning clearance and a confirmation of a site inspection by the Chief Fire Official will be required.

The licensing fee will be \$240.00 plus applicable Zoning Clearance and Awareness Training Course fees.

Application packages are available for pick up between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, in the Clerk's Department, new City Hall, 2141 Major Mackenzie Drive.

Fireworks vendors must make their applications to the Clerk's Department ***no later than 28 days prior to the event in order to be considered eligible for the issuance of a Fireworks License.***
